accompanying Faculty at Qarshi Industry Mess. Souvenirs were given to all faculty members by Mr. Abbas, Manager Qarshi Industries.





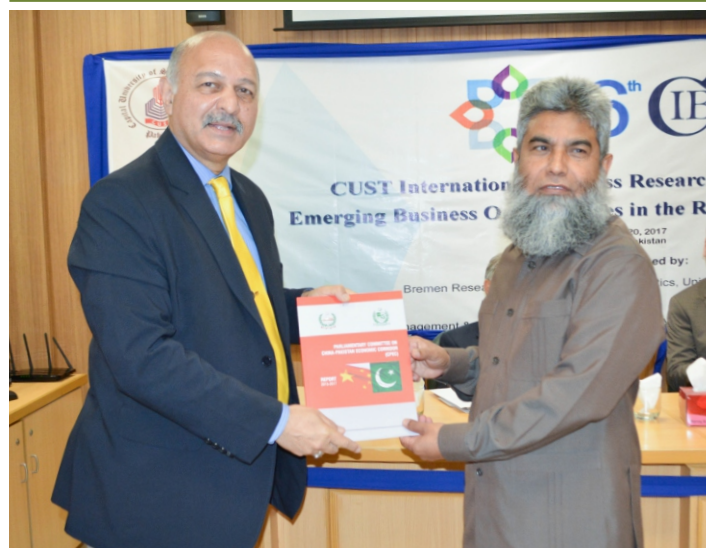


## 6th International Business Research Conference

The uniqueness of this book is that it covers simulation details along with the theoretical concepts of computer networks. The key feature of this book is that it targets various aspects of TCP/IP stack to provide its readership a better perspective both in terms of simulation skills as well as working of TCP/IP. This book considers the implementation of layering perspective of TCP/IP that (to the best of our knowledge) has not been addressed in the available OMNeT++ text.
