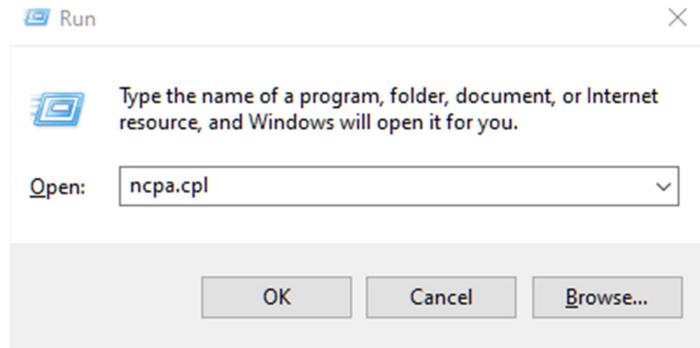
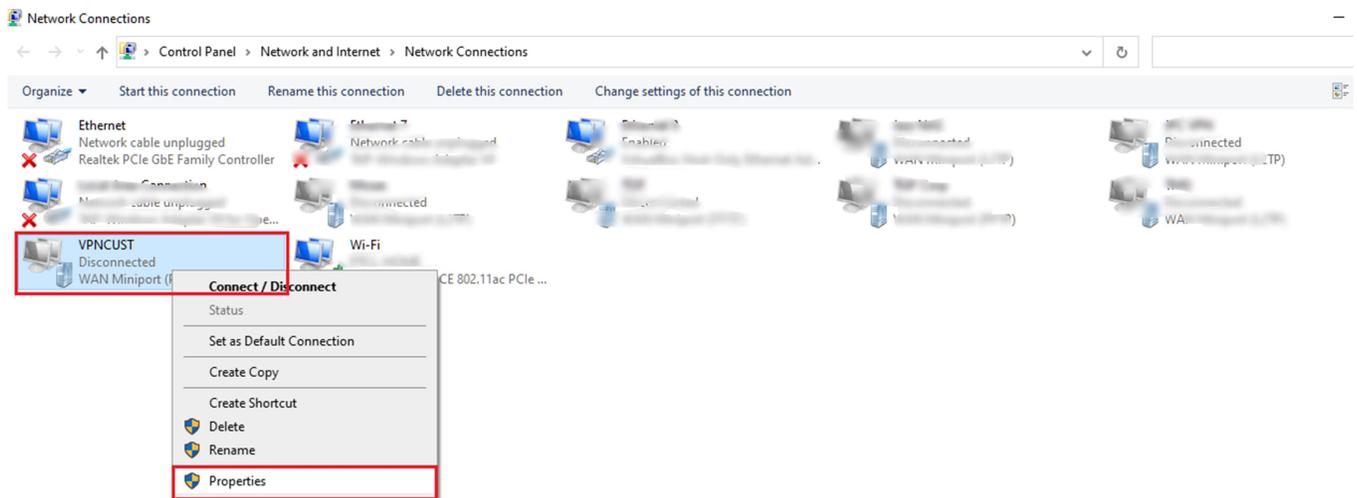


CUST VPN Additional Settings

Step 1: Open Run and type **ncpa.cpl** as shown in the screenshot

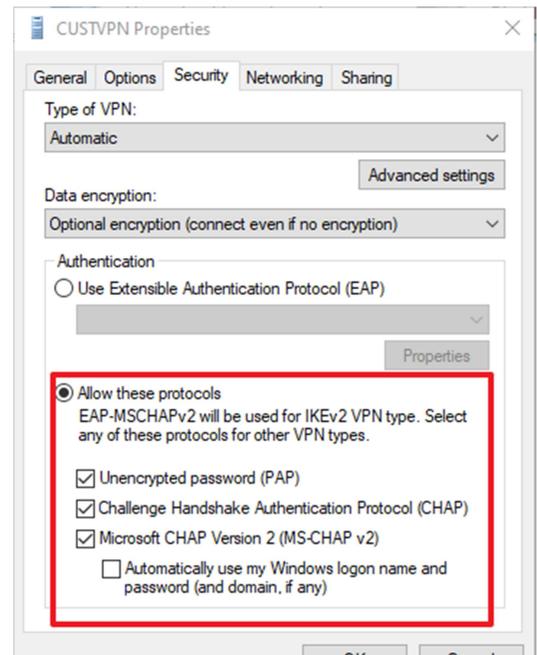


Step 2: Right Click on the **CUST VPN** Connection you earlier created



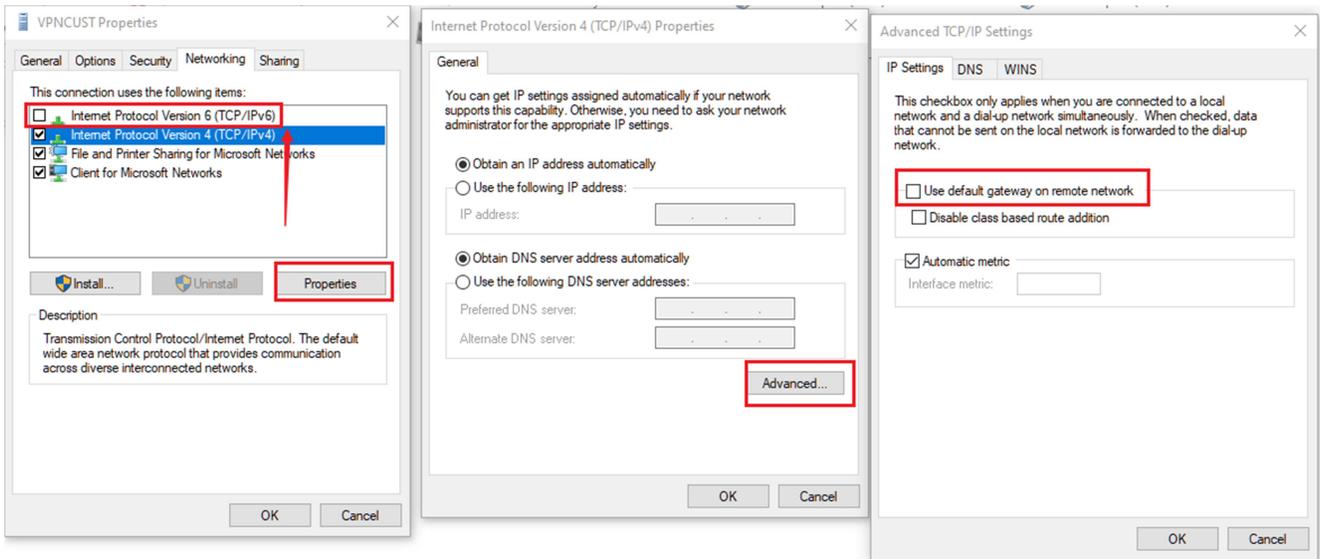
Step 3: Then select **Security Tab** and Select **Allow these protocols** and Tick (Check)

- **Unencrypted password (PAP)**
- **Challenge Handshake Authentication Protocol (CHAP)**
- **Microsoft CHAP Version 2 (MS-CHAP v2)** and Click **OK**

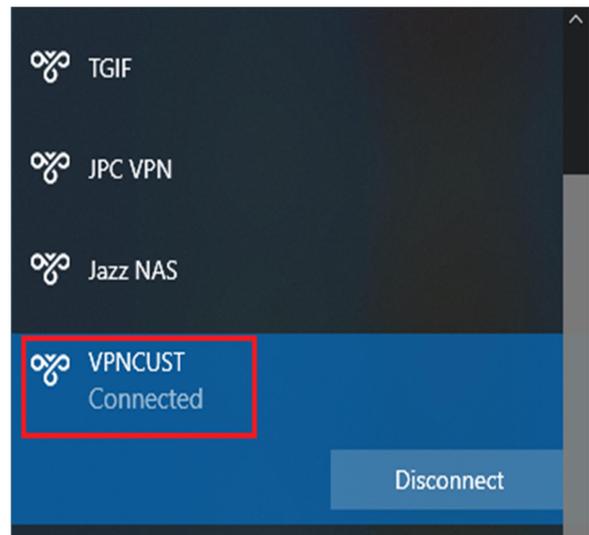
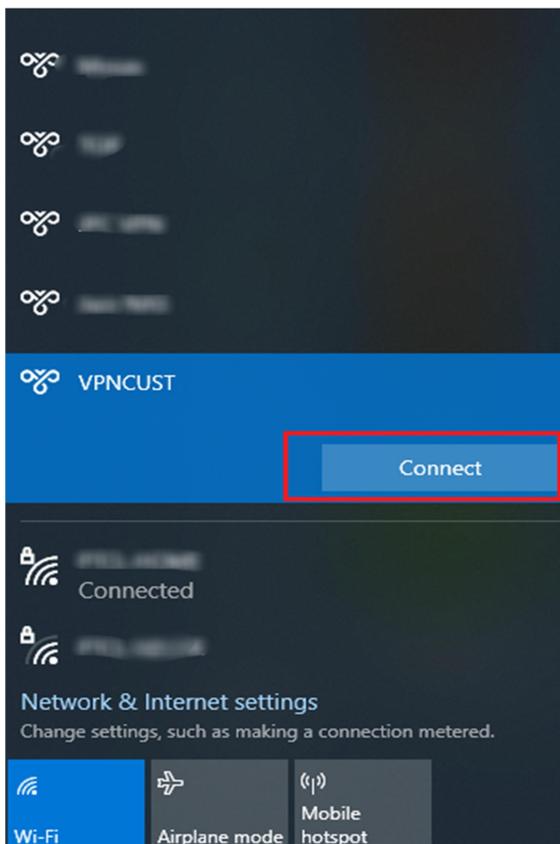


Step 4: Right Click on **CUST VPN** again and Click on **Networking Tab** and Uncheck **Internet Protocol Version 6 (TCP/IPv6)**

and select **Internet Protocol Version 4 (TCP/IPv4)** and Click on **Properties Button** then Click on **Advanced Button** and then Uncheck **Use default gateway on remote network** and click **OK**



Step 5: Now Click on **WiFi/Network** Icon and Select **CUST VPN** and click on **Connect**



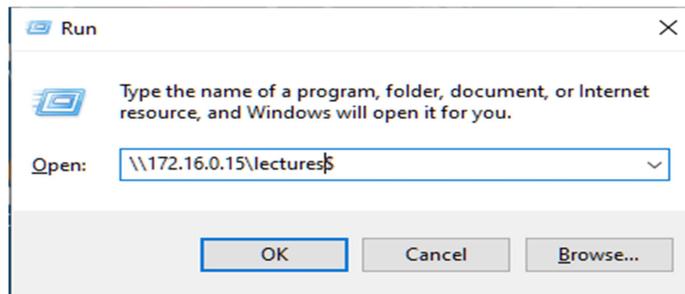
Step 6: To make sure you are connected to the **CUST VPN** Open RUN and type CMD and hit Enter and the type **ping 172.16.0.17** in the command prompt you should get the response from the server. This means you are properly connected to the CUST NETWORK

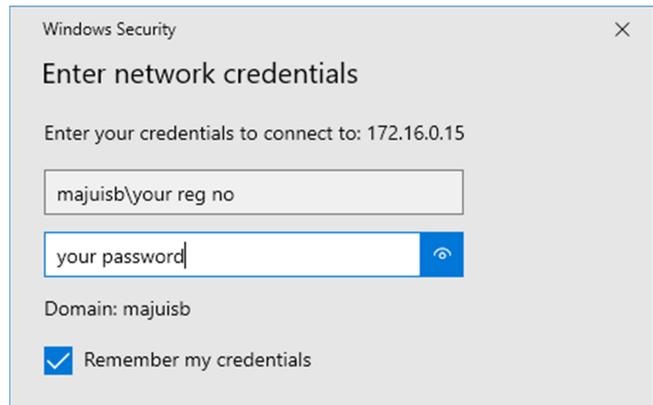
