#### **Course Introduction:**

This course is designed as a compulsory subject for the students of professional degree programs with a focus on their area of specialization. The course has 2 credit hours and carrying 100 marks. A brief history of sources of Islamic law and jurisprudence is a significant part of this course, for example different Schools of thought and their legal position, Islam and contemporary world, Pakistan and Islamization, Islamic culture and civilization and the systems of Islam, Islam and Science. The main objective of this course is to enhance the knowledge of the students on Islam and to build their character according to guidance of Islam
